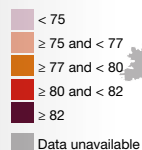

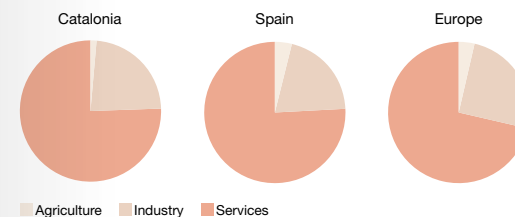

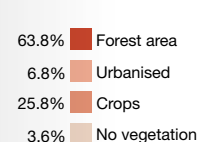

Employed population by sector



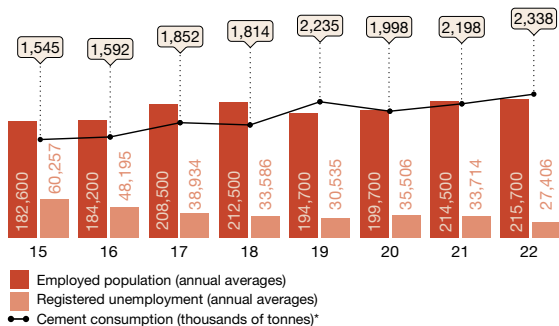

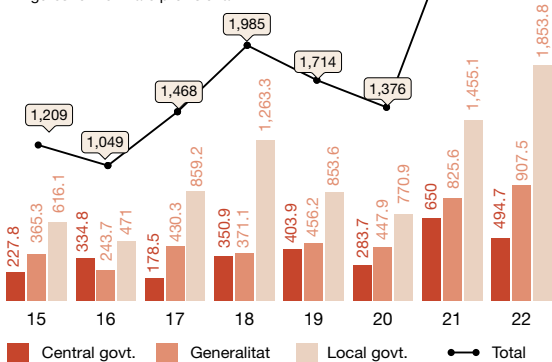

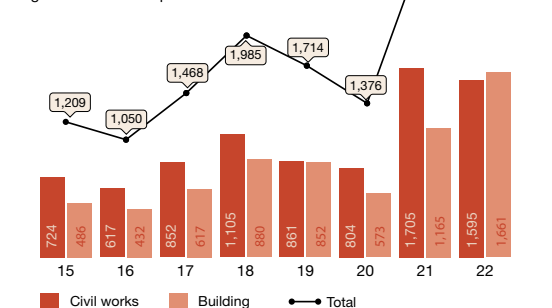
Official tenders for works by contracting agent (millions of euros)

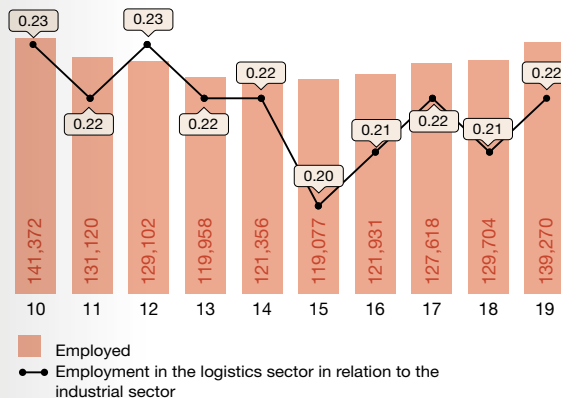
Official tenders for works by type (millions of euros)

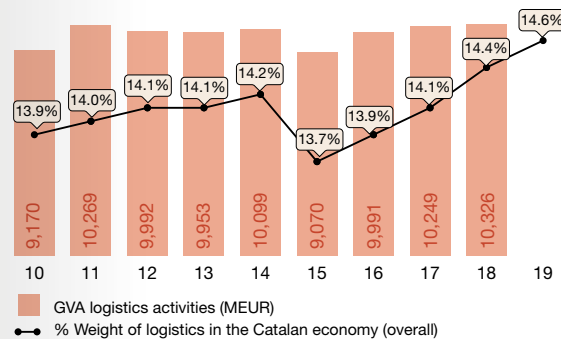


Employment in the logistics sector

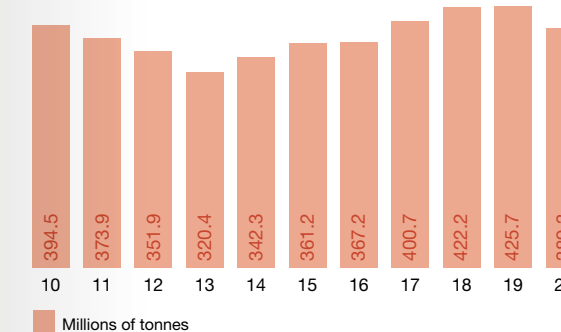

Volume of the logistics system

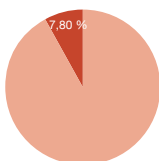
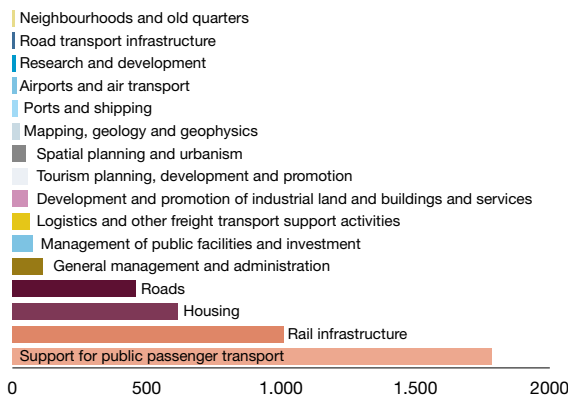

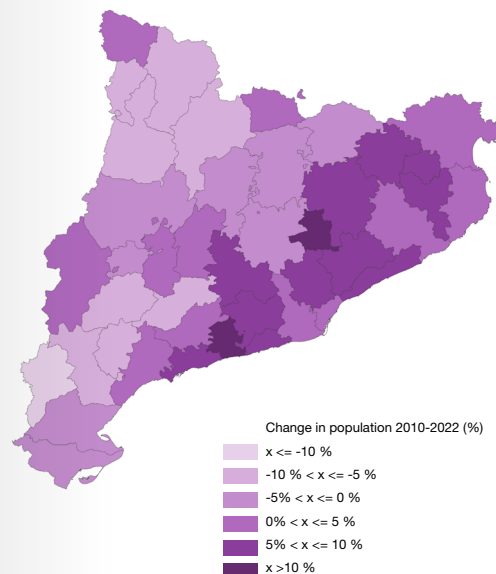

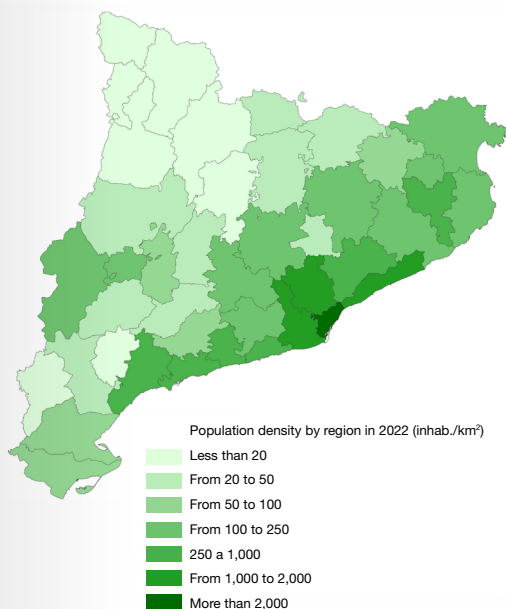

Change in the population of Catalonia by region (2010-2022)



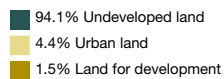
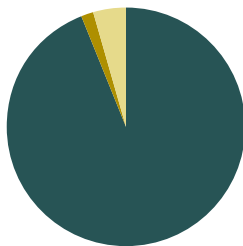
Population density by region in 2022 (inhab./km²)



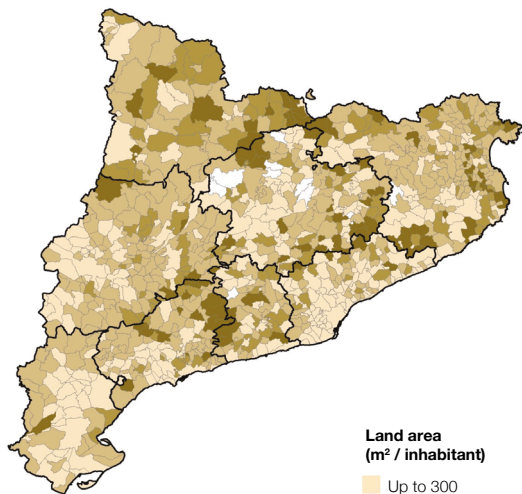

Area by system of land use 2022

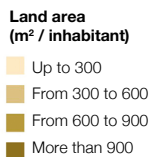

Developed urban land area per inhabitant 2022

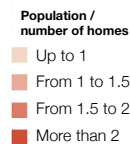
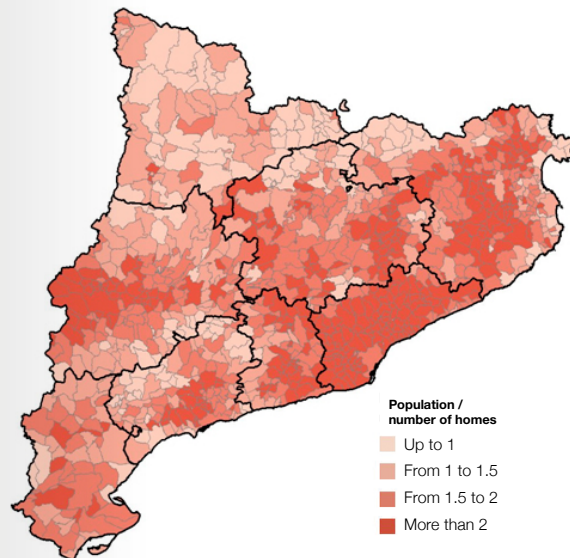

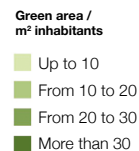
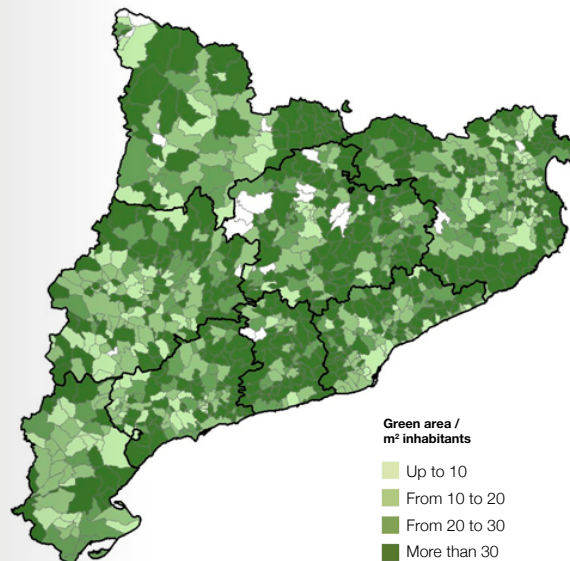
Average occupancy of existing housing 2022

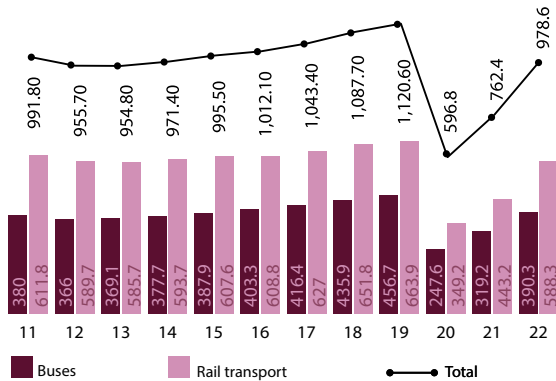

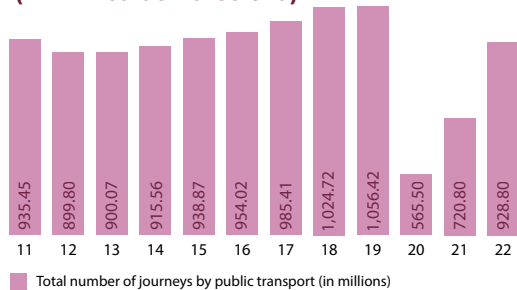

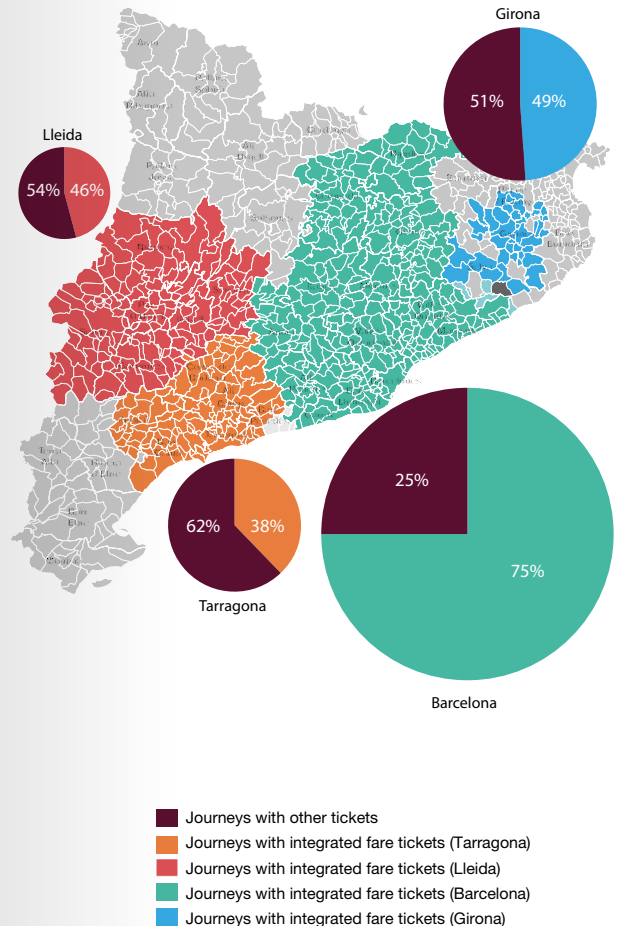
Change in demand for public transport (ATM Area de Barcelona)

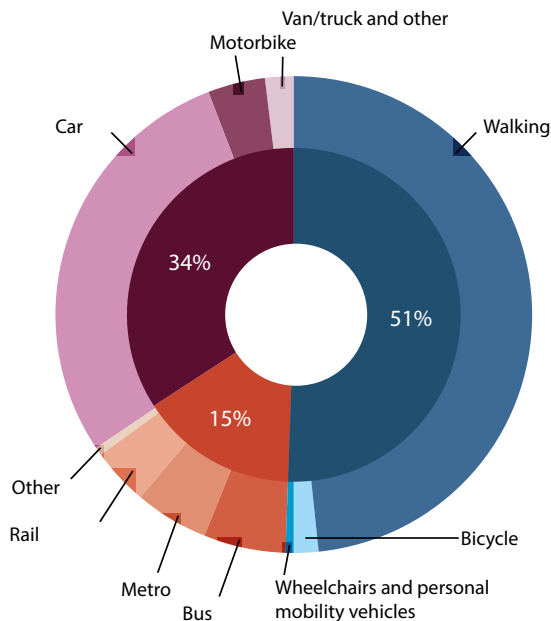

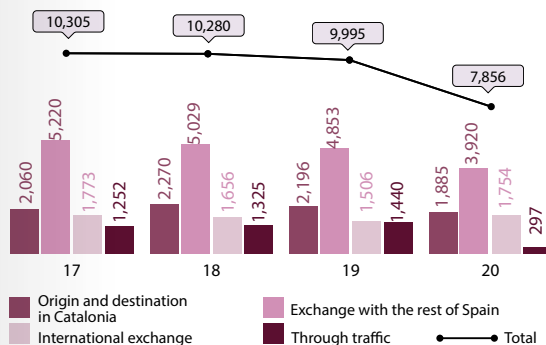

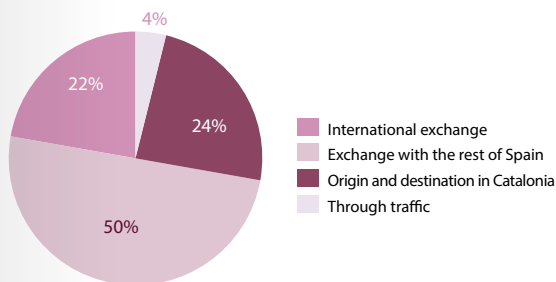

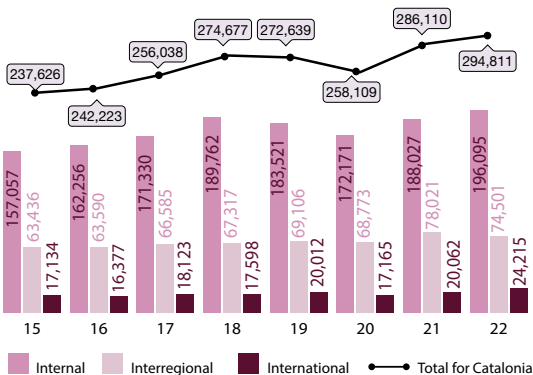


Rail transport: distribution of exchange

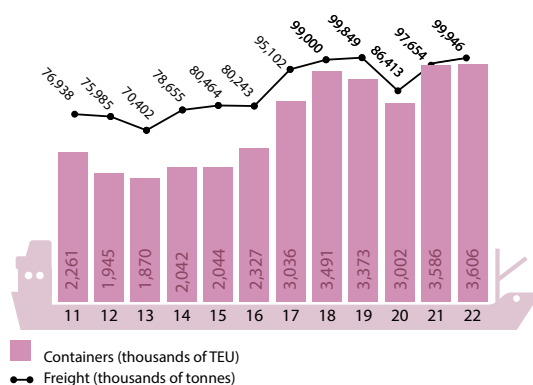

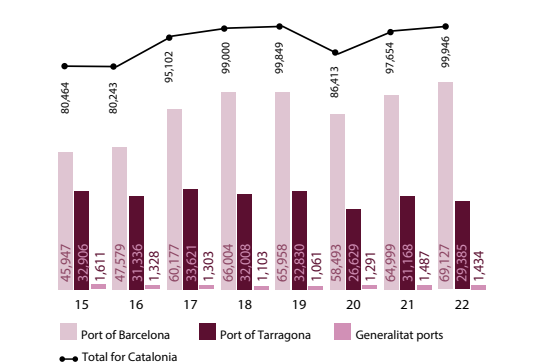
Road transport: freight movement (thousands of tonnes)



Sea transport: freight and container movement

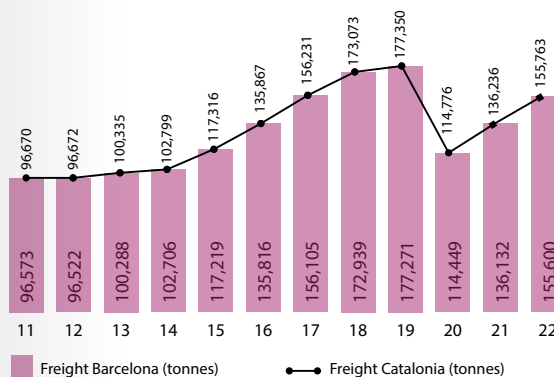


Sea transport: freight movement by port (thousands of tonnes)



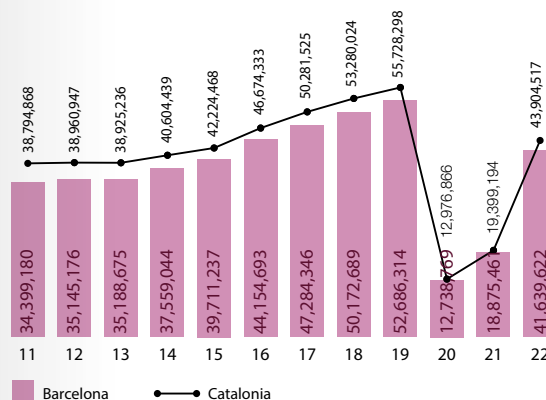

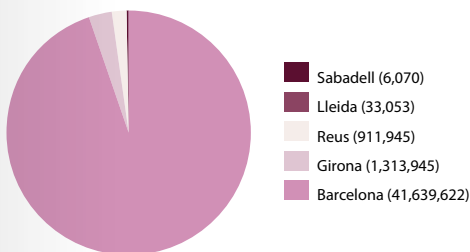
Air transport: passenger movement

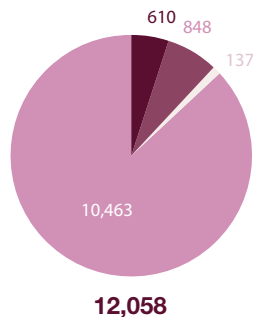

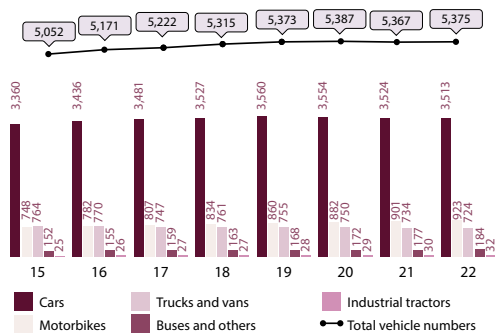

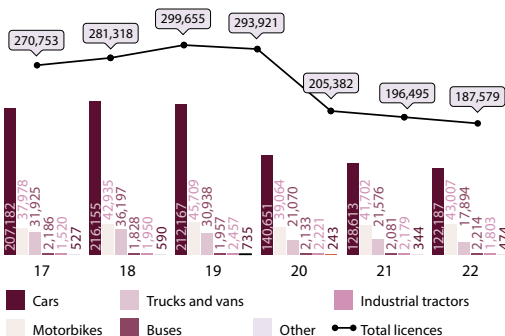

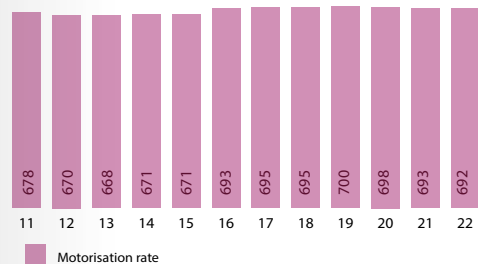

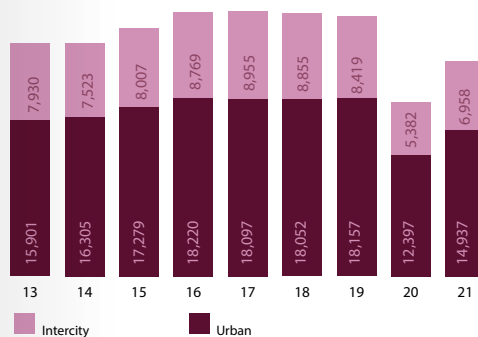

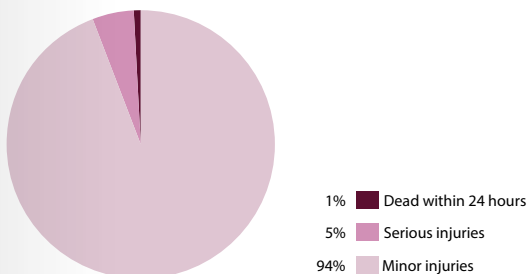


Vehicles per 1,000 inhabitants

Road accidents with casualties (number of accidents)

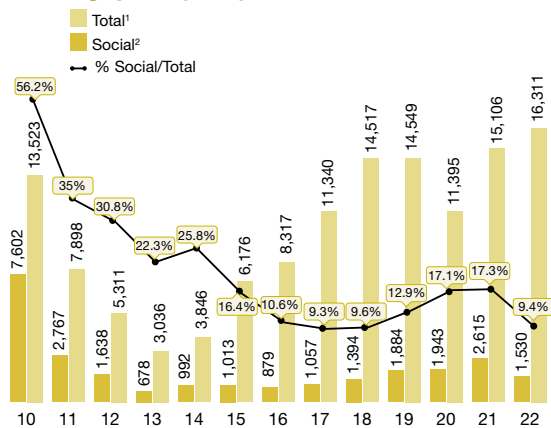

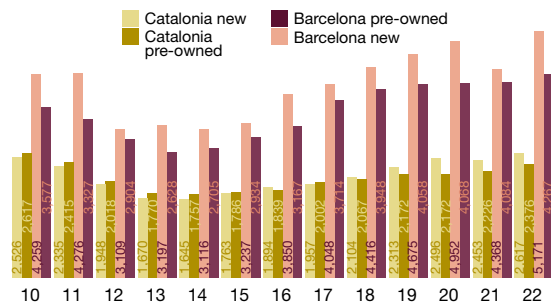
Housing construction and social housing quota (HPO)



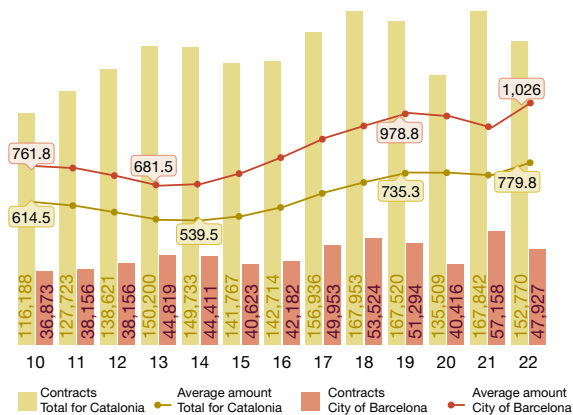

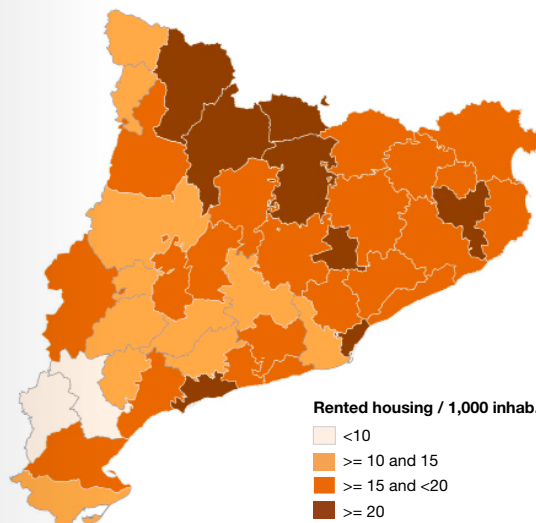
Change in selling price of new and pre-owned housing (euros/m²)



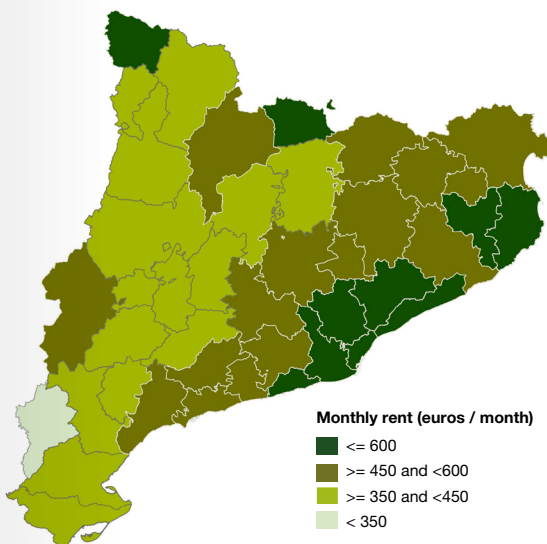
Change in the rentals market



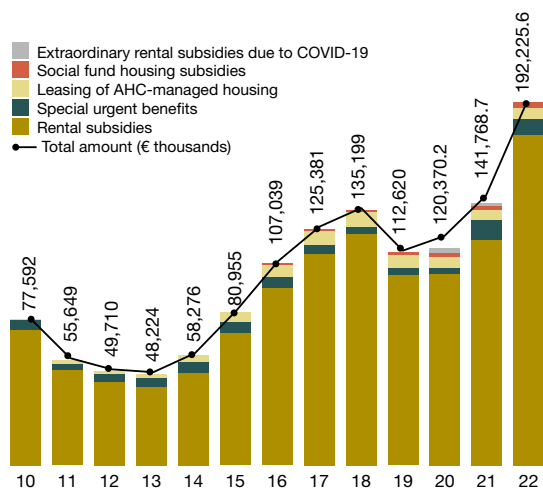
Annual contracts signed per 1,000 inhabitants by region 2022



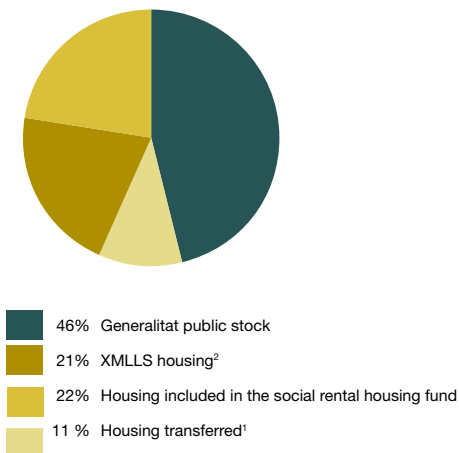
Monthly rent brackets by region 2022
