











### Volume of the logistics system









### Population density by region in 2022 (inhab./km²)










### Developed urban land area per inhabitant 2022

### Average occupancy of existing housing 2022






### Change in demand for public transport (ATM Àrea de Barcelona)






### Sea transport: freight and container movement


### Sea transport: freight movement by port (thousands of tonnes)




### Air transport: passenger movement




### Passengers at Catalan airports 2022




### Road network 2022 (km)








#### **Motorisation rate**








# Change in selling price of new and pre-owned housing (euros/m²)




#### Change in the rentals market



# Annual contracts signed per 1,000 inhabitants by region 2022




# Monthly rent brackets by region 2022


