







#### Public tenders for works by type (millions of euros)




#### **Employment in the logistics sector** (number of people)

#### Logistics system volume (millions of tonnes)










#### Zoned urban land area per capita 2019








# **Evolution of public transport demand** (Barcelona Metropolitan Transport Authority, MTA)








### Railway transport: distribution of interchanges



#### Road transport: movement of goods (thousands of tonnes)










#### Air transport: movement of passengers (millions of passengers)










#### Water consumption (1000s of m3)




#### Water consumption by regions (1000s of m3)




## Number of treatment plans and flow treated (1000 m3/day)




