

WHAT IS MULTI-LEVEL GOVERNANCE?

Cross-cutting, multi-level governance

- A shared commitment of all administrations to achieve the digital and green transitions for Catalonia
- The coordination of urban and territorial strategies between different administrations
- In implementing the Agenda for Towns and Cities Catalonia 2050, promotion of an integrated governance model that enables a comprehensive perspective and overcomes the silo effect in public policies
- Public-private action strategy

Social and civic vision

- Progress towards citizen involvement and co-responsibility strategies when planning urban habitats
- Promote an intersectional vision, where gender, class, ethnicity, sexual orientation, age, etc. are taken into account in urban policy strategies and their implementation
- Incorporate urban planning elements to build healthy, safe and enjoyable habitats for children
- Guarantee and move forward democratic quality

TERRITORIAL BALANCE

Promote territorial balance by creating competitive advantages for living, working and enjoying every corner of the territory

Liveable and Sustainable environments

Progress towards complex and polycentric urban models, with a balance between residential density, economic activity and other uses; healthy and resilient, with open, nearby, high quality, green spaces that are permeable with the surrounding open spaces; safe, accessible and inclusive.

Promote and integrated territorial planning that addresses the interrelations between habitats and nature, taking into account urban centres, natural territory, mountains, coastline and the unique characteristics of each environment

Connectivity

Connect and add structure to every corner of the territory. Moving towards a balanced model between the Metropolitan Area of Barcelona, intermediate and small cities, towns and villages and neighbourhoods, creating new centralities that enable more local services, facilities and work centres in Catalonia

Progress towards territorial equity through a commitment to connectivity infrastructures both physical and digital. Develop integrated, multimodal, collective, connected, decarbonised, inclusive and safe model of mobility as a service (MaaS).

Energy and natural resources

Move towards a carbon neutral energy model, based on the internet of energy: decentralised and based on prosumers (producers and consumers), networked and digital, universal, local, based on clean and renewable energies, and on efficiency and reduced consumption.

Ensure efficient use of natural resources and circular management of waste.

Natural heritage and resilience

Harness nature to improve the quality of life. Enhance urban and peri-urban green and blue infrastructure as a system that provides eco-systemic services, enhancing its value and increasing its surface area, in order to halt biodiversity loss. Focus on nature-based solutions (NBS) to increase the resilience of the territory to face climate change.

Create economic dynamism and prosperity by reinforcing traditional sectors, new production models, and new opportunities in the digital and green economy

High value-added digital and green economy

Transform the productive sectors with social impact for the future. Promote disruptive business models by using the economic potential of the territory and improve competitiveness and industrial employment, modernise the secondary sector; promote knowledge clusters, promote new technologies, facilitate creativity and innovation and seek greater added value when producing products and services.

Talent and entrepreneurship

Promote talent generation, in accordance with future needs of the productive sector, focusing on the digital capabilities, and on continuous learning in accordance with technological and digital advances.

Establish the territory as an environment that attracts and retains talent, placing value on competitive factors such as infrastructures, the digitalisation of the economy, hybrid forms of work and quality of life.

Research and technology transfer

Promote a missions oriented scientific and technological research to boost the productive sector and the competitive reinforcement of the economy.

Promote scientific and technological assets and infrastructures in Catalonia, making the most of the leading research centres and science and technology parks, establishing mechanisms to achieve transfer of knowledge.

Circular economy

Ensure the transition to a circular and green economic and consumption models; incorporate resource efficiency principles at every stage of the value chain, from extraction, production, transport, consumption, treatment and waste recovery.

Progress towards a more equitable society and a new social contract that guarantees fundamental rights and leaves no one behind

Cohesive and inclusive society

Guarantee and enable acces and permanence to adequate housing for the entire population, as well as to the basic services and supplies, and the fundamental rights, including digital rights that guarantee their well-being.

Healthy and safe quality of life

Guarantee and ensure people's wellbeing and quality of life by promoting and encouraging healthy and safe environments and habits.

Promote environments and habits for happiness, well-being and enjoyment throughout their lives, as well as physical and personal interaction.

Citizen-focused digital public services

Promote quality digital public services that are interoperable between administrations, citizencentred, and that respond to future social needs, and that are able to do so proactively, anticipating social demand, and on a personalised basis, offering a service tailored to personal and specific territorial characteristics.

Identity and culture

Promote cultural assets taking advantage of the opportunities of the digitalization and connectivity, the catalan language and the physical and intangible heritage of the whole territory, and at the same time recognize and dignify the heritage cultural of the diversity of people who live there, like a tool for social integration and rooting. These assets must also serve to encourage cultural interaction between cities and towns to create cultural axes in territory, taking into account the cultural diversity of the people who live there.
